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### **Performance Notes**

This document is the reference score: a performance part for viola is separate.

Here, the middle five staves display the instrumental voices of the computer-generated audio accompaniment of the toccata.

The bottom grand staff displays the more ethereal computer-generated music of the prelude and interludes. The notated rhythms of these interludes are approximate and rather rubato.

The viola can be amplified (miked) if necessary. In any case, the viola should not strain to be heard, and the whole should not be overly loud.

The computer-generated audio is available in a number of formats for performance.

#### CD-ROM:

a four-channel version as mono audio files in 48kHz, 24 bit format, (preferred); stereo 48kHz, 24 bit audio files; stereo 44.1 kHz, 16 bit files audio files.


